Overview

Living Water Community is a Catholic Lay Ecclesial community, founded in Port of Spain in 1975 by Rhonda Maingot and Rose Jackman when they responded to a call from God to **“Light a fire of love”** in the hearts of people.

Comprised of a dedicated staff of volunteers, the Community has a vibrant ministry to the poor in Trinidad – the physically poor and the spiritually poor. In a world where the illiterate, hungry, homeless and destitute spill on to the streets every day, addressing the myriad needs for basic care, nourishment and self-development programs is managed in an efficient, cost-effective manner. All of this is made possible through the generosity of those who support the ministry by Deeds of Covenant, Donations, Charitable Foundations, Legacies, Fundraising, and the Bookstore and Coffee shop.

The Community’s television and video production studio, Trinity Communications Network, is also located on campus, with a small chapel on the ground floor for quiet prayer and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, as well as a large hall on the first floor where the Community meets and where Mass is celebrated each day.

On September 8, 2013, the Roman Catholic Archbishop took a bold and pioneering step to improve the reach of Trinity Communication Network, launching its own 24/7 cable channel, the first in the Caribbean region. Trinity TV was introduced to millions of American viewers during Telecare’s annual Telethon from New York cable channel.

This communications ministry serves the Archdiocese of Port of Spain through coverage of its major events and promotion of its vision for the local Church. In addition, Trinity TV broadcasts in Trinidad via all the major cable providers, as well as in Barbados, St. Vincent, the Grenadines, St. Lucia and Jamaica, through FLOW. Trinity TV’s viewing audience has increased overall by 40%. Some of their prime-time programs have climbed from 10% to over 35% from all stations surveyed.

Sunday and daily live Mass coverage continues to attract a large audience and in all cases, surpasses the competition by 20%.

Besides its existence on the line-up of all the major cable providers in Trinidad and Tobago since February 2005, TCN has a digital presence that includes Facebook, Instagram and an internet radio station, Trinity Radio – all of which can be conveniently accessed through its Mobile App. In addition, TCN has been live-streaming its content on its website www.tcn-tt.com.

Because of its unprecedented growth, it has become necessary for Trinity TV to have an additional functioning studio to expand its outreach even further with quality programming and live tapings.

Project Snapshot

Global Humanitarian Mission strongly supports Living Water Community ministry. In its **49-year** history, its service to the poor in the surrounding communities of Port of Spain is unquestionable, and it has become the cornerstone of this city.

Trinity Communication Network and Trinity TV are proof of the ministry's tremendous growth and authenticity, as well as its commitment to the Church Apostolate. Recently, through generous donor-support, Studio B was created, from which programming and live tapings are already being aired.

However, there is even greater growth potential envisioned for Trinity TV studios!

The Network is excited to expand its programming even more with the addition of small group productions that will include praise and worship-type mini concerts, presentations in the style of 'Ted Talks' with small audiences, and a Bible Quiz game show, with teams from various Archdiocesan parishes. This will entail modernizing and re-designing the larger Trinity TV Studio A to facilitate this new program content and accommodate an audience area of 10-12.

Global Humanitarian Mission is privileged to partner with this ministry, in the advancement of innovative outreach and evangelism, and invites you to become a part of this exciting new venture.

GHM is establishing this project for the re-design of **Studio A**, which entails the following:

- Renovation of an existing 22ft x 10ft studio, including
 - Building walls
 - Purchasing and installing acrylic panels
 - Stage flooring, circular raised moveable 5ft platform, mounted on casters
 - Triangular wedge-shaped moveable platform
- Purchase of equipment, including
 - 4 Robotic cameras
 - 4 Tripods
 - 4 Smart TVs
 - Robotic camera control system
 - Wireless intercom system
 - Microphones, monitors and Mic stands
 - Video wall controller for screens, mounts

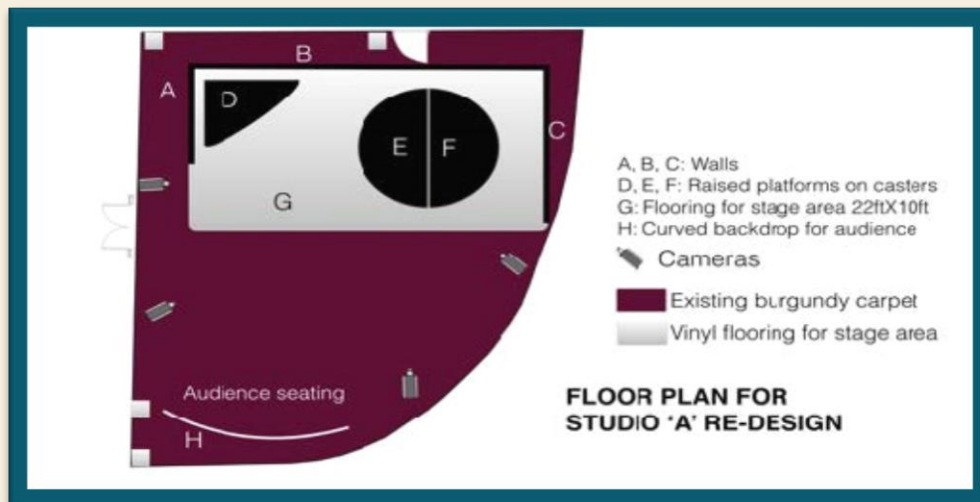
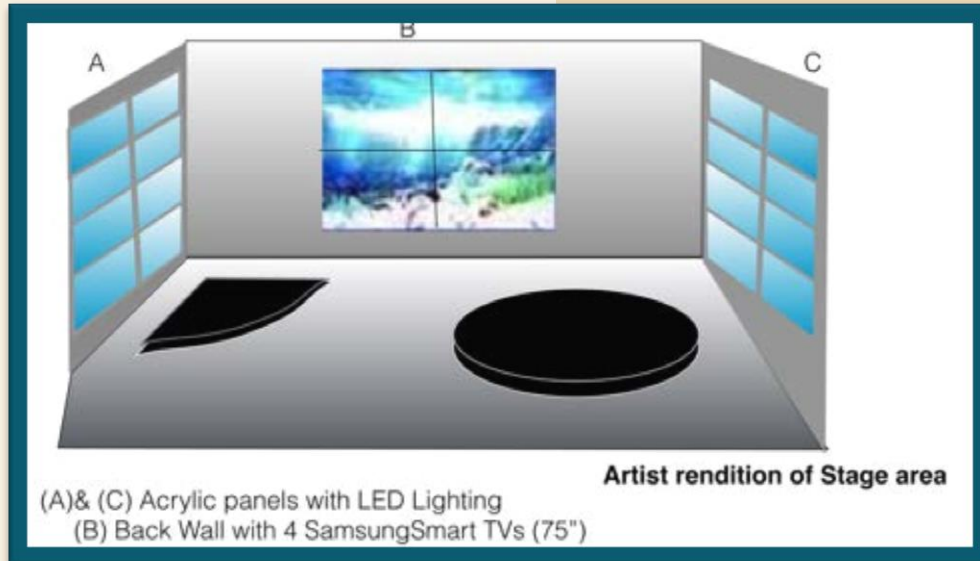
The backdrop and seating of the small audience area will be provided by local friends of Living Water Community.
