# MAMAN MARIE CHILDREN'S HOME



Beni,
Democratic Republic of the Congo

#### **Overview**

For three decades, the people of eastern Congo have been subject to unrest.

In 2014, rebels went on a random killing spree in Beni and its surrounding villages, leaving in their wake families torn apart and thousands of orphans. In 2019, UNICEF and its partners determined that 1,380 children became new orphans, losing either one or both parents to the Ebola outbreak. Today, more than 3,000 children are orphans in Beni, desperately in need of a home.


In 2020, Pastor Thomas Ongasa, President of **Train Them 2 Fish, Congo**, a non-profit organization. encountered 62-year-old Marie with no money, taking care of 33 children. Pastor Ongasa, himself an orphan from an early age, was moved to launch a special project during the COVID crisis, to provide the children with reusable face masks and food distribution. The organization also receives occasional gifts of school books, tuition sponsorships, clothing and food. One generous donor is even in the process of adopting one of the children.

## Project Snapshot

- Shop


